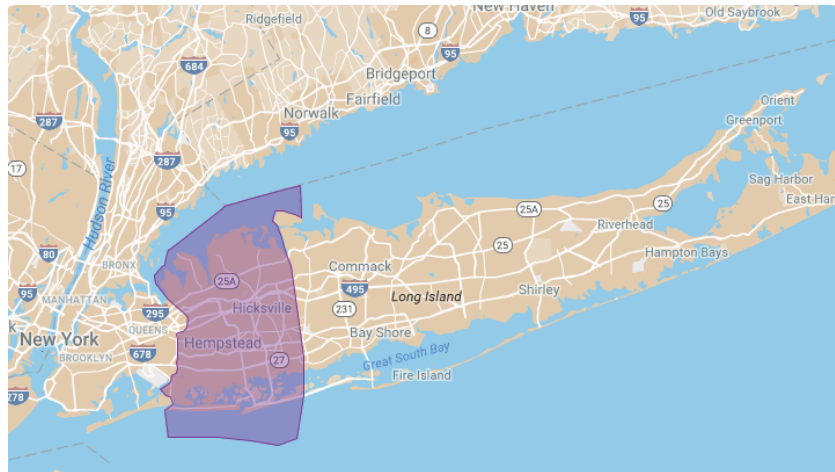

The Candidates (Open Seat)

Jack Martins (R)

As the mayor of Mineola, Jack Martins reduced the village's debt and delivered balanced budgets. As a state senator, he served as the Chair of the Labor Committee and had a 100% voting record supporting CSEA's priorities.

As County Executive, Martins will support CSEA members and their families. He understands that our county workforce has been stretched to its limits, that NIFA has overstayed its welcome, and that corruption needs to be taken seriously.

In an October 23rd Newsday article, Martins said, "I reject the fact that we have to lay people off, cut services or somehow go out and increase fees in order to make ends meet."

Martins also opposes a constitutional convention that would put pensions at risk.

Laura Curran has served on the Nassau County Legislature since 2014 after serving as a Trustee on the Baldwin Board of Education from 2011 to 2014. Curran has said that concessions from county unions could be an option to balance the budget.
