

## COLOR-CODE FOR WORKPLACE HAZARDS MAPPING

<b>Red</b>	biological hazards (e.g. blood, mold, fungus, infectious diseases, etc.)
<b>Orange</b>	ergonomic hazards (hazards that result in back or repetitive strain injuries)
<b>Yellow</b>	stressors/work design hazards (e.g. understaffing, problems with work load or work space, overtime, shift work, production quotas, problematic management techniques, threat of or actual harassment or violence, etc.)
<b>Dark Blue</b>	physical hazards (e.g. noise, vibration, radiation, poor lighting, lack of ventilation, etc.)
<b>Green</b>	chemical hazards (e.g. solvents, asbestos, silica, latex, formaldehyde, cleaning chemicals, metal dust, diesel fumes, copier or printer fumes, etc.)
<b>Light Blue</b>	safety hazards (e.g. unguarded or unsafe machines or equipment, confined spaces, electrical hazards, fall hazards, slippery floors, lack of training, etc.)
