COLOR-CODE FOR WORKPLACE HAZARDS MAPPING

Red	biological hazards (e.g. blood, mold, fungus, infectious diseases, etc.)
Orange	ergonomic hazards (hazards that result in back or repetitive strain injuries)
Yellow	stressors/work design hazards (e.g. understaffing, problems with work load or work space, overtime, shift work, production quotas, problematic management techniques, threat of or actual harassment or violence, etc.)
Dark Blue	physical hazards (e.g. noise, vibration, radiation, poor lighting, lack of ventilation, etc.)
Green	chemical hazards (e.g. solvents, asbestos, silica, latex, formaldehyde, cleaning chemicals, metal dust, diesel fumes, copier or printer fumes, etc.)
Light Blue	safety hazards (e.g. unguarded or unsafe machines or equipment, confined spaces, electrical hazards, fall hazards, slippery floors, lack of training, etc.)
