DMNA 25-Year Retirement



What was the law before?

Division of Military Affairs (DMNA) firefighters in Tier 6 had to work until age 63. Other professional firefighters can retire after 20 years of service



What is the law now?

DMNA firefighters can now receive a pension equal to 50% of their final average salary after 25 years of service



Who does this impact?

Firefighters employed by DMNA, who are state employees, but work at three Air National Guard Bases across the state: Stewart, in Newburgh; Stratton, in Scotia; and Gabreski, in Westhampton
