

Federal Budget Cuts in H.R. 1

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW



\$10 billion is removed from the NYS Budget



\$13 billion is removed from Healthcare facilities



\$3.4 trillion is added to the national debt



300,000 workers will lose SNAP benefits



200,000 jobs will be cut statewide



1.5 million New Yorkers will become uninsured

What does this mean for the state budget?

New York State will need to adjust the budget to account for a **\$750 million deficit** in this fiscal year and a **\$3 billion deficit** next year.

IMPACT ON CSEA MEMBERS:

Cuts to federal assistance affect every CSEA-represented position.

New York State will need to fill the gap made by the increased deficit. Here are some ways that might happen:

- **Increased taxes**
- **Cuts to programs and services**
- **Layoffs and hiring freezes**
- **Closing healthcare facilities**
- **Fiscal austerity - no reforms to Tier 6, less generous CBAs**
