30/55 FOR COURT OFFICERS

A bill has passed both houses to provides court officers and peace officers employed by the Unified Court System with the ability at retire at age 55 with 30 years of service.

RECOGNIZES THE WORK OF COURT OFFICERS AS LAW ENFORCEMENT



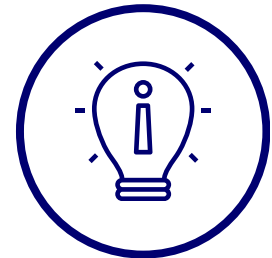
WHAT WAS THE LAW BEFORE?

Court officers in Tier 6 were required to work 30+ years before being eligible to retire.



WHO DOES THIS IMPACT?

Tier 5 and 6 Court officers and peace officers employed by the Unified Court System.



WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

This gets court officers closer to pension parity with other law enforcement titles.
