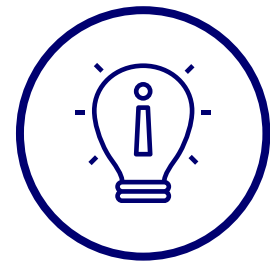
WHAT WAS THE LAW BEFORE?

Work zone speed cameras could only be used on "controlled-access" highways — roads where drivers enter and exit only by ramps.



WHO DOES THIS IMPACT?

Highway workers employed by the State Department of Transportation, Thruway Authority, and Bridge Authority.



WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

Work zones on any high-speed roadway are dangerous. When a camera is present, drivers slow down.
